- [3] Yes- I have the title w/ Sustainability in it- but sustainability is infused throughout our organization: Recycling Team, Safety, Health and Environment in our facilities, Natural Resource Managers to monitoring and manage our spring water.
- [4] Company is decentralized, serves local markets, field based.
- [5] There is no single position, all positions work collectively to advance their environmental initiatives.
- [6] Sustainability Officer and a Sr. Sustainability Analyst
- [7] Yes, packaging, water and energy are our focus area. Please see our Source blog for the latest on these programs.
- [8] Here at CED DbA All-Phase Electric Supply it is a way of life. Our building is 100% LED. All lighting has occupancy sensors. We have low volume flush toilets and waterless urinals. We use Dyson hand dryers rather than paper towels. We recycle.
- [9] DCI is FSC certified and a member of the Rainforest Alliance which prohibits the use of any rainforest species, and ensure our materials are coming from a renewable source.

[32] "We do not measure the waste that our company generates annually, because Humanscale's facilities produce very little. We produce a small amount of controlled waste that our Piscataway facility qualifies as a "conditionally exempt small quantity generator" which generates less than 220 lbs per month and is not required to register with the EPA. Most of our waste is non-hazardous and recyclable, as a result we recycle everything we can and landfill only when we have to. We produce some waste that must be disposed of in a controlled way and follow all the EPA guidelines and local and state laws for disposal."

However, for WAXIE-branded products which are manufactured for the company, post-consumer and total recycled content is specified wherever practical.

[40] "Our packaging has a minimum of 35% post-consumer recycled content and up to an 85% recycled content overall."

[41] No that is impractical as it would waste more gas picking it up. We do re-use most boxes.

[42] "We do not offer reusable shipping containers, however we do try to use as little packing materials as we can while still keeping the product safe. We do however offer blanket wrapping for large chair orders."

[43] Qualified yes – as stated previously, WAXIE distributes several thousand different products from several hundred different vendors, and as a distributor we don't always have control over the packaging which is provided. However, for WAXIE-branded products which are manufactured for the company, packaging is frequently packaged in material which contains post-consumer recycled content, and is itself recyclable.

[44] all of the products are packaged in cardboard

[45] We support more efficient and effective recycling and for many years supports Recycling Reinvented a non-profit that is working to increase recycling rates through policy change.

[46] "we have a buy back program whereby we issue a credit for the old furniture to be used towards new. The old furniture is re-purposed. It does not go into a landfill."

[47] "Working with our dealer partners we offer three options; donation, refurbish, and recycle."

[48] Some categories, but not all.

[49] "We have a sustainability vendor survey to obtain written documentation from vendors to confirm information about materials, manufacturing processes and social responsibility policies. We also have a Design-for-Environment program to ensure certain materials that don't meet our sustainability requirements (e.g. PVC) will not be used in our products."
